

2025 Baltimore Putting Championship Finals Rules July 23rd

This 9 hole Putting Championship will be contested on Wednesday, July 23rd beginning at 6:00 pm at the Mount Pleasant Golf Course's practice green.

- 1. Play will be governed by the rules of golf of the U.S.G.A. except where a local rule is defined.
- 2. All equipment must fall within the guidelines of the U.S.G.A.
- 3. Balls used by contestants must conform to U.S.G.A. specifications.
- 4. Score cards will be exchanged within the group so that no competitor keeps their own score. (Players may note their own score on the bottom of the score card for verification purposes). Each score card must be signed by the scorer and attested by the competitor upon completion of play before it is turned into the Score Board Committee.
- 5. Players are allowed to read the break of each hole from where their ball lies and walk to the hole. Players are NOT allowed to walk behind the hole at any time.
- 6. Contestants who are not on the course will be required to remain in the clubhouse prior to beginning their round.
- 7. If there is a tie for first place, second place or third place, a putt-off will take place. The putt-off will start on the first hole, and will continue until someone wins.
- 8. If a player that qualified for the Finals arrives after all other qualifiers have completed their round, the player that arrived late is disqualified from competing in the Finals.
